SCHOOL FEES 2025

The Family Fee & Curriculum expenses were increased in line with the directive of the Sandhurst Catholic Education Office. The elements of the 2025 School Fees are explained below:

Family Fee

The 2025 Family Fee for St Michael's Primary School is;

1 Child \$1370.00 2 Children \$1675.00 3 Plus Children \$1885.00

Student Fee

The student fee reflects the cost of the learning and teaching program at different year levels. A table showing payment across each year level is included below.

We would like to remind families that these are the total costs for the 2025 school year and there are no other additional costs throughout the year for excursions, buses or events.

Payment of Fees

Billing Invoices will be prepared and sent at the commencement of the Term 1 2025.

Camps, School, Excursion Fund (CSEF)

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) provides payments for eligible Health Care Card Holder students to attend activities like camps and excursions. The CSEF is paid directly to the school and will be allocated by the school towards camps, sports and/or excursion costs for your child. Payment amount is \$150 per primary school aged child in 2024.

Your Obligation as part of your enrolment contract:

You have agreed to a financial commitment and have agreed to pay fees and charges for your enrolled child.

The following payment frequencies are available for your convenience:

- Fortnightly / Weekly – Direct deposit via bank account
- Monthly – from February to December
- Triannual – Due in March, June and September (3 payments)
- Annual – 31 st March (1 payment)



Camps Participation in the Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 camps are compulsory and a requisite to the school curriculum, fee refunds will not apply. In extenuating circumstances, camp fees may be refunded if approved by the school Finance Officer no later than 60 days prior to the scheduled camp date.

The costs of camps have increased due to the changes in the supplier costs of camps and the staff Enterprise Bargaining Agreement.

Fee Assistance & Health Care Card

If a parent(s)/guardian(s) believe they may be unable to pay the fees in full, it is requested that they discuss this with the school finance officer as soon as possible. Assistance may be available to families in cases of financial hardship and applications will be reviewed on an annual basis. For further information, please contact our Finance Officer, either via email or phone.

Families who hold a current Health Care Card will be provided with a fee rebate to their overall fee charges for the year and will be charged no more than \$520 per year (excluding uniforms) This equates to \$10/Week. This will be applied at the start of the year once the Healthcare Card information has been obtained.
